Description of Deviation:

The weather station was struck by lightning during a storm on July 27, 2011. Numerous attempts were made, with the help of Spectrum Technologies, the technical support group, to connect to the weather station and retrieve the data. After attempting all diagnostic tests, it was determined by Spectrum Technologies that the weather station was destroyed, and all data was lost. The last data downloaded was on July 15, 2011.

Effect of Deviation on Compliance:

The weather station failed to record data for more than a 7 day period.

Estimate of Excess Emissions:

No emissions associated with this event.

Cause of Deviation:

Lightning struck the pump house building, on which the weather station is mounted, destroying the weather station and all data that was recorded in it.

Corrective Action or Preventive Action Taken:

A new weather station was ordered on 8/2/11, which will be installed as soon as it is received.
